# REINSTATE Your LICENSE

In OREGON



The Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles can revoke or suspend your driver's license for the following reasons:

**DUI violations**

Failure to pay child support

Failure to appear in court

Multiple traffic offenses



If you fail to appear in court, the DMV may suspend your license for **10 years** or until it receives proof that the court has dismissed your case.



In Oregon, the ~~cost~~ **state charges of getting your driver's license reinstated is**

**\$75** Remove - period to reinstate your license.

Make sure to comply with any additional conditions imposed by the court.

You ~~might~~ **will** need **SR-22 insurance** to get your driver's license reinstated.

The **SR-22 filing proves** You may be required to purchase **SR-22 insurance to show** that you comply with Oregon's minimum liability **vehicle insurance rules.**

After ~~paying a small fee, you'll receive a certificate proving that you're properly insured.~~

Once the state processes your SR-22 filing, you can reinstate your license.
